

Tours



Tours are available online and onsite on a range of themes and can be tailored for your group's needs and interests. These are some of our most popular tours:

Abbey Highlights

Discover the Abbey as a place of history and faith exploring our most famous spaces and memorials.

Royalty

Walk in the footsteps of kings and queens to uncover royal stories from coronation mishaps to key historical moments.

STEM

In Scientists' Corner, discover minds that asked big questions which continue to shape the STEM field today.

Faith

Journey through this church where all are welcome; explore signs, symbols and sacred stillness.

History

Medieval Monks to Victorians, Tudors to Georgians, our 1,000 year history has plenty to dive into.

Projects

We work with groups to develop short-form projects as opportunities to build employability skills, reflect and explore creativity.

Projects might explore a specific theme, story or space within the Abbey over several visits (onsite or virtual).

Final projects might take the form of:


- Artwork

Onsite Tour (45-60mins)

£4 - per young person
I adult per 10 young people visit free of charge

£14 - Additional adults.

This does not include adults acting as 1:1 support or carers, who visit the Abbey for free.

Onsite Workshop (30-40mins)

£1 per young person
This must be booked as an add on to a tour

Virtual Session (60mins)

£30 per group

Bursaries are available for onsite and virtual sessions
